Health Requirements: All llamas must be registered with the ILR. All llamas must have a health certificate issued within 30 days of the fair. **Out-of-state** Virginia requires out-of-state llamas be tested and found negative for TB, brucellosis and blue tongue within 120 days of the fair.

Youth Divisions

Junior: 8 yrs as of 8/1/09 to 10 years as of 1/1/09

Intermediate: 11 to 13 years as of 1/1/09

Senior: 14 to 18 years as of 1/1/09

Novice: Youth in their first year of showing.

Advanced: Youth with at least one year of showing experience.

Combining/Splitting classes: Fiber types of the same age in the non-suri division will be combined if there are four or less entries in that age category. Two-year old and older classes will be split if the resulting classes each have three or more entries. Intermediate/Senior classes may be split if the resulting classes each have three or more entries. The non-suri division will be split if there are at least eight entries in each fiber category.

Light/Medium: Smooth to minimal leg and head coverage

Medium/Heavy: Moderate to abundant leg and head coverage.

MORE INFORMATION

Entry Fees: The entry fee per llama is \$20 for unlimited classes (halter and open). The entry fee for each youth is \$20 for unlimited youth classes (up to three). The \$2 ILR fee applies once to for llama entered in the show, whether the llama is entered in open classes, youth classes or both.

Qualifier: Top three placements will automatically qualify you and/or your llama for a invitation to the East Coast Invitational Championship show. October 10-11, 2009, Charlottesville, Virginia.

Show Ring: We'll be showing under tent this year. (Yay!) ...Albeit a *very* small ring. If we run late or if the weather is nice we may move outside.

Stalling: There will be *limited stalling* in the equine tent for exhibitors. These stalls will be reserved first for use by volunteers, sponsors and out-of-state llamas or long-distance in-state llamas. **Please call ahead** for availability and to reserve stalling space. \$25/per stall. Limit 2 stalls per farm. Farms bringing animals for display any time between July 28 - July 30 do not have to pay for stalling during the show.

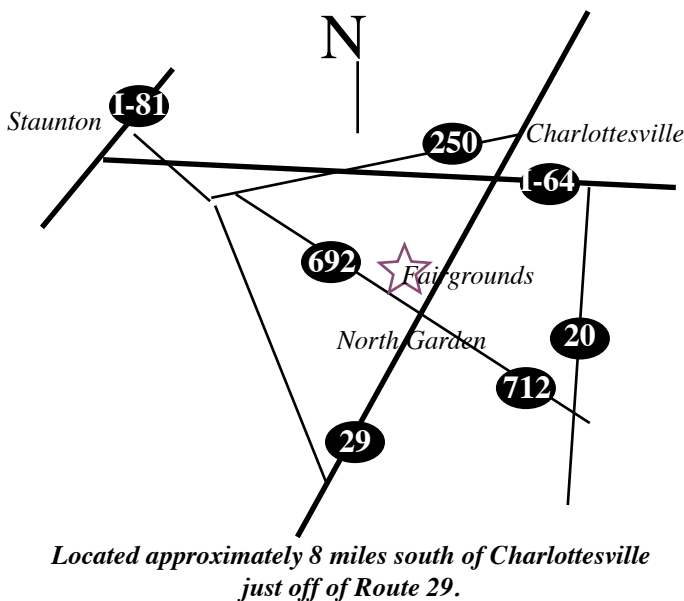
